Effect to be given to the recommendations of sectoral meetings

(c) Tripartite Meeting on the Social and Labour Impact of Globalization in the Manufacture of Transport Equipment (Geneva, 8-12 May 2000)

- **1.** The Tripartite Meeting on the Social and Labour Impact of Globalization in the Manufacture of Transport Equipment was held in Geneva from 8-12 May 2000, chaired by Mr. E. Patel (Worker member of the Governing Body).
- **2.** The Meeting considered a report prepared by the Office. ¹ It unanimously adopted a set of conclusions and a resolution concerning the future work of the ILO in transport equipment manufacturing.
- **3.** These texts, together with a summary of the proceedings of the Meeting, appear in the *Note on the Proceedings*, which is appended to the present paper. ² Paragraphs 8, 15 and 16 of the conclusions and operative paragraphs of the resolution call for certain action by the ILO.
- 4. The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body authorize the Director-General to communicate the Note on the Proceedings containing the texts mentioned in paragraph 3 above –
 - (a) to governments, requesting them to communicate these texts to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned;

- (b) to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned;
- (c) to the international organizations concerned.

The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body request the Director-General to bear in mind, when drawing up proposals for the future work of the Office, the wishes expressed by the meeting in paragraphs 8, 15 and 16 of the conclusions and in the relevant part of the resolution.
