Composition of the ILO Administrative Tribunal

1. Article III, paragraph 2, of the Statute of the ILO Administrative Tribunal provides: “the judges shall be appointed for a period of three years by the Conference”. The Tribunal currently has the following composition:

Judges:

Mr. Michel Gentot (France), President: term of office expires in July 2001;

Ms. Mella Carroll (Ireland), Vice-President: term of office expires in July 2002;

Mr. Seydou Ba (Senegal): term of office expires in July 2003;

Mr. Jean-François Egli (Switzerland): term of office expires in July 2001;

Mr. James K. Hugessen (Canada): term of office expires in July 2003;

Ms. Florida Ruth P. Romero (Philippines): term of office expires in July 2003;

Ms. Hildegard Rondón de Sansó (Venezuela): term of office expires in July 2003.

2. Since the terms of office of Mr. Gentot and Mr. Egli will expire in July 2001, it is proposed to extend them by another three years.
3. *The Committee is accordingly invited to recommend to the Governing Body that it submit to the International Labour Conference, for adoption at its forthcoming session, the following resolution:*

The General Conference of the International Labour Organization,

Decides, in accordance with Article III of the Statute of the Administrative Tribunal of the International Labour Organization, to renew the appointment of Mr. Michel Gentot (France) and that of Mr. Jean-François Egli (Switzerland) for a term of three years.
