



THIRD ITEM ON THE AGENDA

**Effect to be given to the
recommendations of sectoral meetings****Tripartite Meeting on Labour Practices in the
Footwear, Leather, Textiles and Clothing
Industries (Geneva, 16-20 October 2000)**

1. The Tripartite Meeting on Labour Practices in the Footwear, Leather, Textiles and Clothing Industries was held in Geneva from 16 to 20 October 2000, chaired by Ms. L. Sasso-Mazzufferi (Employer member of the Governing Body).
2. The Meeting considered a report prepared by the International Labour Office.¹ It unanimously adopted a set of conclusions and a resolution concerning future ILO action in the footwear, leather, textiles and clothing industries.
3. These texts, together with a summary of the proceedings of the meeting, appear in the *Note on the Proceedings*, which is appended to the present paper.² Paragraphs 26-31 of the conclusions and the operative paragraphs of the resolution call for certain action by the ILO.
4. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body authorize the Director-General to communicate the Note on the Proceedings containing the texts mentioned in paragraph 3 above –*
 - (a) *to governments, requesting them to communicate these texts to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*
 - (b) *to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*
 - (c) *to the international organizations concerned.*
