Programme and Budget for 2002-03

Regular budget account and Working Capital Fund

1. Information on the position of 2002-03 income and expenditure as at 30 September 2002 is submitted herewith. Additional information on the position of member States in relation to the receipt of contributions is provided in Appendices I and II. Appendix I gives details of contributions received and amounts due as at that date, while Appendix II gives details of those member States which, as at 30 September 2002, had lost the right to vote under the provisions of paragraph 4 of article 13 of the Constitution.

Budgetary income and expenditure

2. Budgetary income is accounted for in US dollars at the ILO budget rate of exchange for the financial period, and Swiss franc expenditure is recorded in US dollars at the same rate of exchange. US dollar budgetary income and expenditure figures reported herein accordingly result from the conversion of Swiss franc income and expenditure to US dollars at the 2002-03 budget rate of exchange of 1.77 Swiss francs to the US dollar. Assessed contributions received and expenditure recorded as at 30 September 2002 were as follows:

Contributions of member States

- **3.** Total assessed contributions for 2002 amount to 384,125,400 Swiss francs compared with 357,593,093 ¹ Swiss francs for 2001. Appendix I indicates that, as at 30 September 2002, assessed contributions for 2002 received from or credited to member States ² totalled 174,115,608 Swiss francs, which represented 45.3 per cent of the contributions assessed. At the same date in 2001, 45 per cent of the 2001 contributions had been collected. At 30 September 2002, some 77 member States had settled their 2002 contributions in full, 25 member States had made partial payments, while 73 others had made no payments against 2002 contributions. This compared with 87, 21 and 67 member States in the same situation respectively at the same date in 2001.
- **4.** Arrears of contributions received to 30 September 2002 totalled 18,167,619 Swiss francs, bringing total contributions collected to 30 September 2002 to 192,283,227 Swiss francs.
- **5.** As at 30 September 2002, 18 States (Angola, Bahamas, Burkina Faso, Cameroon, Costa Rica, Côte d'Ivoire, Cuba, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Grenada, Guyana, Latvia, Nicaragua, Nigeria, Panama, Senegal, Turkey, Uganda and Ukraine) had made payments against their 2003 contributions.

Position in relation to paragraph 4 of article 13 of the Constitution

- **6.** Appendix II shows that, on 30 September 2002, the arrears of contributions of Afghanistan, Antigua and Barbuda, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Chad, Comoros, Congo, Djibouti, Gambia, Georgia, Iraq, Kyrgyzstan, Lao People's Democratic Republic, Republic of Moldova, Paraguay, Sao Tome and Principe, Sierra Leone, Solomon Islands, Somalia, Tajikistan, The former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia, Togo, Turkmenistan and Uzbekistan equalled or exceeded the amount of the contributions due from them for the past two full years (2000-01). Each of these member States had therefore lost the right to vote, in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 of article 13 of the Constitution of the Organization.
- 7. Albania, Belarus, Cambodia, Cape Verde, Central African Republic, Democratic Republic of the Congo, Dominican Republic, Guinea-Bissau, Kazakhstan, Latvia, Liberia, Poland, Ukraine and Viet Nam are permitted to vote in accordance with paragraph 4 of article 13 of the Constitution of the Organization under financial arrangements approved by the International Labour Conference: 81st (1994) for Albania, 86th (1998) for Belarus, 82nd (1995) for Cambodia, 85th (1997) for Cape Verde, 89th (2001) for Central African Republic, 89th (2001) for Democratic Republic of the Congo, 85th (1997) for Dominican Republic, 90th (2002) for Guinea-Bissau, 88th (2000) for Kazakhstan, 87th (1999) for Latvia, 88th (2000) for Liberia, 75th (1988) for Poland, 88th (2000) for Ukraine and 81st (1994) for Viet Nam.

¹ The original assessment of Sw.frs.357,614,550 was adjusted to reflect the change in the assessment rate between the Federal Republic of Yugoslavia and the Former Socialist Republic of Yugoslavia.

² Amounts credited against 2002 contributions represent the distribution to eligible member States of incentive scheme credits, cash surpluses and the net premiums earned in prior periods. Details are given in footnote 1 to Appendix I.

Working Capital Fund

8. In accordance with article 21 of the Financial Regulations, the Working Capital Fund was drawn upon to finance budgetary expenditure pending receipt of contributions. The nominal balance of this fund standing at 35 million Swiss francs was fully exhausted. ³
