Effect to be given to the recommendations of sectoral meetings

- (c) Tripartite Meeting on the Employment Effects of Mergers and Acquisitions in Commerce (Geneva, 7-11 April 2003)
 - **1.** The Tripartite Meeting on the Employment Effects of Mergers and Acquisitions in Commerce was held in Geneva from 7 to 11 April 2003, chaired by Mr. O.A. Omotade, Government member of the Governing Body.
 - **2.** The Meeting considered a report prepared by the International Labour Office. ¹ It unanimously adopted a set of conclusions, and one resolution concerning future ILO activities in commerce.
 - **3.** These texts, together with a summary of the proceedings of the Meeting, appear in the *Note on the proceedings*, which is appended to the present paper. ² Paragraphs 18-21 of the conclusions and the operative paragraph of the resolution concerning future ILO activities in commerce call for action by the ILO.
 - 4. The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body authorize the Director-General to communicate the Note on the proceedings containing the texts mentioned in paragraph 3 above:
 - (a) to governments, requesting them to communicate these texts to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned;
 - (b) to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned;
 - (c) to the other international organizations concerned.
