



SECOND ITEM ON THE AGENDA

**Effect to be given to the recommendations
of sectoral meetings****(d) Tripartite Meeting on Challenges and
Opportunities facing Public Utilities
(Geneva, 19-23 May 2003)**

1. The Tripartite Meeting on Challenges and Opportunities facing Public Utilities was held in Geneva from 19 to 23 May 2003, chaired by Mr. Mel Lambert, Employer member of the Governing Body.
2. The Meeting considered a report prepared by the International Labour Office.¹ It unanimously adopted a set of conclusions and one resolution.
3. These texts, together with a summary of the proceedings of the Meeting, appear in the *Note on the proceedings*, which is appended to the present paper.² Paragraphs 11-13 of the conclusions and the operative paragraphs of the resolution call for action by the ILO.
4. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body authorize the Director-General to communicate the Note on the proceedings containing the text mentioned in paragraph 3 above:*
 - (a) *to governments, requesting them to communicate the text to the employers' and workers' organizations concerned;*
 - (b) *to the international employers' and workers' organizations concerned; and*
 - (c) *to the other international organizations concerned.*
5. *The Committee on Sectoral and Technical Meetings and Related Issues may wish to recommend that the Governing Body request the Director-General to bear in*
