## FIFTEENTH ITEM ON THE AGENDA

**Report of the Director-General****Eighth Supplementary Report: Chief Internal Auditor position – Recommendation**

1. According to the Staff Regulations, article 4.2(d), and article 14.20 of the Financial Rules, the position of Chief Internal Auditor shall be filled by the Director-General after consultation with the Governing Body. This document informs the Governing Body of the steps taken by the Director-General before submitting his proposal, as presented to the Officers of the Governing Body on 23 March.
2. An internal/external call for candidatures was made in respect of the position of Chief Internal Auditor. The call was posted on the ILO web site and in both *The Economist* and the *International Public Auditor*. A total of 82 applications were received. In keeping with standard procedures, all applications were reviewed in order to establish a list of candidates to be interviewed. Four candidates, three external and one internal, were interviewed by a panel of senior ILO managers, which then submitted its report and recommendation to the Director-General.
3. The Director-General is proposing Ms Keiko Kamioka to fill the position. Ms Kamioka is a 53-year-old Japanese national, who holds a BSc in accounting from the University of North Carolina and is a Certified Public Accountant. She joined the ILO in 1998 and is currently Chief, Treasury and Accounts Branch, a position that she has held for the past six years. Her duties include the coordination of responses to internal and external audits and managing the production of audited accounts. Ms Kamioka is also a member of the Accountability Committee, the SHIF Management Committee and the Reports Board. Prior to joining the ILO, Ms Kamioka worked in the United Nations Development Programme as a Senior Finance Policy Adviser for nine years. Previously, she was employed as a Senior Auditor with KPMG Peat Marwick Main and Company in New York.
4. ***In light of the above, the Governing Body may wish to express its support with the proposal of the Director-General.***
