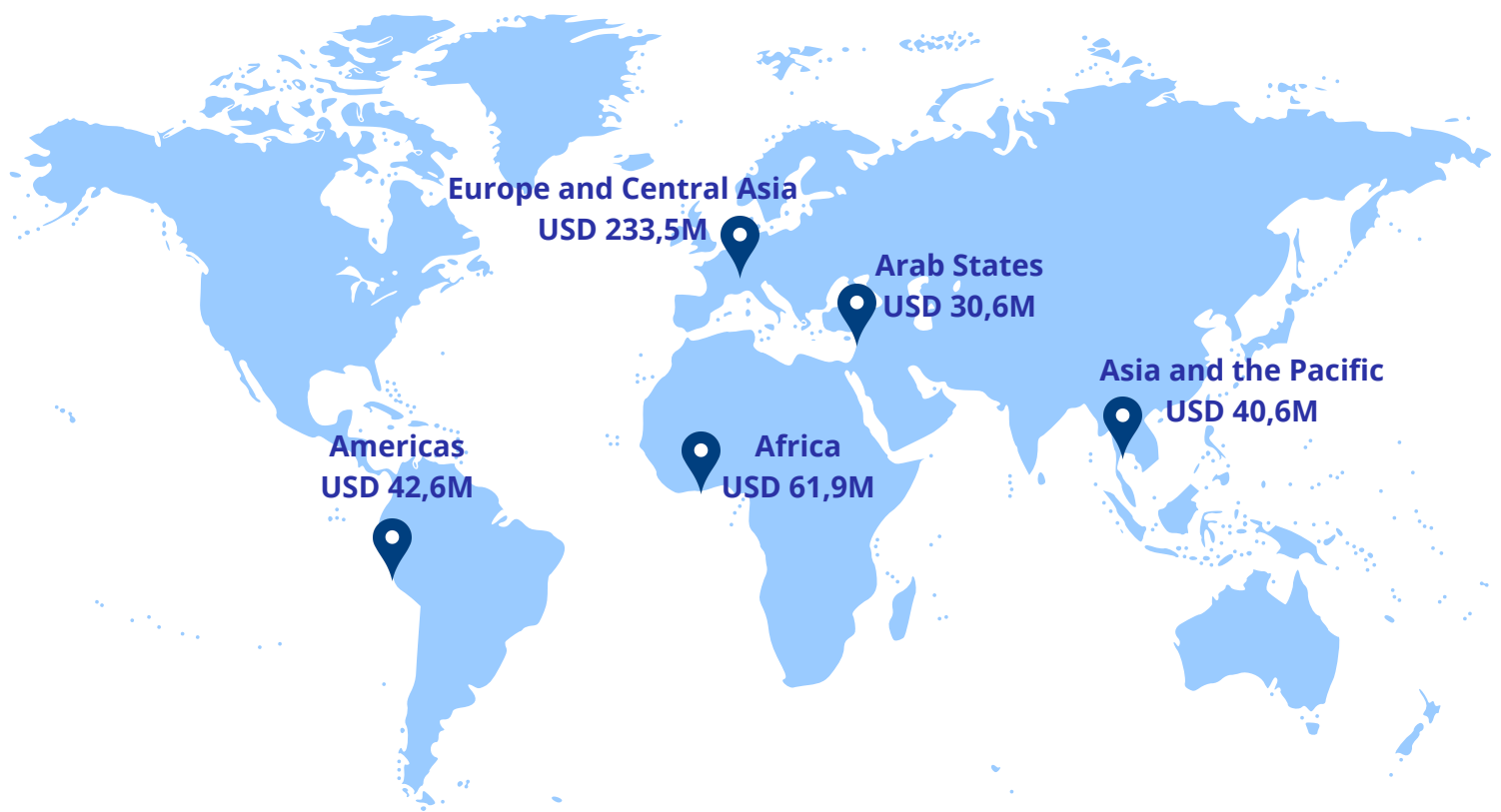
ILO SUSTAINABLE TENDERS

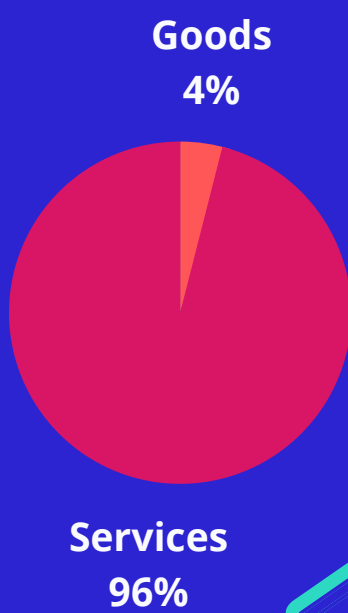

This is the breakdown of spend per ILO region, including the Regional Offices of Latin America and the Caribbean, Africa, Europe, Arab States, and Asia

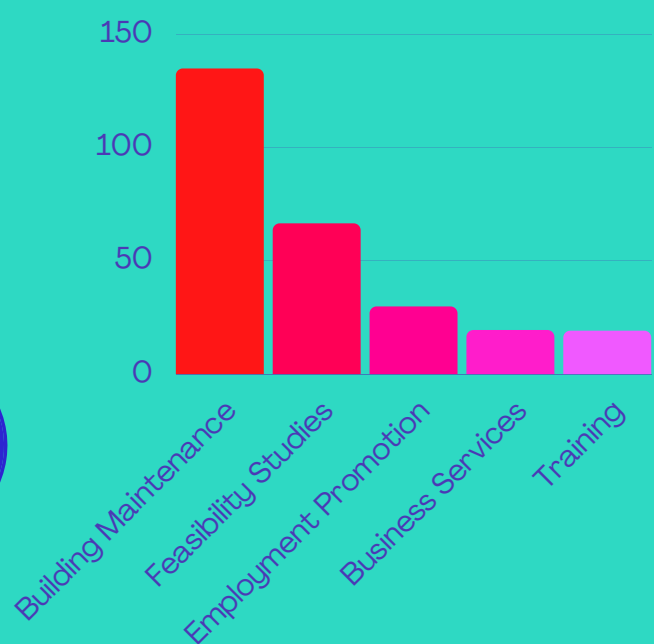


GOODS VS SERVICES
