

# Re engineering of YEN


### Key knowledge gaps and constraints:

# Impact Evaluation

An assessment of the causal effect of a project, program or policy on beneficiaries. *Uses a counterfactual...* 

•To estimate what the state of the beneficiaries would have been in the absence of the program (the control or comparison group), compared to the observed state of beneficiaries (the treatment group), and

•To determine intermediate or final outcomes attributable to the intervention.

### Youth to Youth Fund YEN – Competitive Grant Scheme

### **Target countries:**

- Sierra Leone, Liberia
- Guinea, Cote d'Ivoire

### Approach:

### **Facts and Figures**

Applications received: 270

Winners selected: 15

Grant sizes: \$7,000 - \$50,000

Total Grants: \$450,000

Total Beneficiaries: 900 youth

- Grant competition for innovative pilot projects led by youth
- Youth participation + innovation > youth employment

### Intervention areas:

- Community projects and services
- Youth entrepreneurship
- Transition from school to work
- Vocational training for young people

### Strengths

- Being an inter agency Secretariat is a selling point
- Focused and targeted products
- Good team with technical expertise
- Lean structure

- Weak funding basis, low financial commitments from partners
