

1. Overview

The International Labour Organization, together with the Second Vice-Presidency and Ministry of Labour and Social Economy of the Government of Spain, have the honour to share with all delegations, practical information on the International Technical Forum of Senior Labour Inspectors: "*The new ILO guidelines on general principles of labour inspection and the future of work,*" to be held in the city of Valencia, Valencian Community, on 17 and 18 November 2022. 

The organizers will provide transportation for participants between the hotel and meeting places, as well as where the dinners and social events will be held.






